As a new patient to our office we would like to extend a warm welcome and thank you for choosing our practice.

**What to expect:** A first visit at our office generally consists of a full eye examination including pupil dilation. This has the effect of temporarily increasing some patients' sensitivity to light and blurs some patients' near vision. You should plan on being here for approximately 1 1/2 hours. To make this time well spent, please review the enclosed items. You will find history and insurance forms that may be filled out in advance and brought to the office on the day of your examination. If the purpose of your visit is decreased vision possibly due to cataracts, there is a vision preference questionnaire as well as a visual disability questionnaire. Filling these out beforehand will help us understand the nature of your problem in addition to allowing us to understand the way that you would like to be able to see in the future. Lastly, we have enclosed a booklet which thoroughly explains cataract surgery. Reading it before your visit will help you to understand the procedure and help you to identify questions that you may wish to ask the doctor on the day of your visit.

**What to bring:** Please bring your medical insurance cards, a list of all medications and dosages, ALL pairs of eyeglasses that you currently use as well as the packaging or information for any contact lenses that you wear. Family members are welcome to accompany you to the office as well as into the examination room with the doctor.

**Contact lens wearers:** You must not wear your lenses for at least 2 weeks prior to your visit for accurate measurements.
